

SUNLAND SPRINGS VILLAGE (SSV) LADIES 18-HOLE GOLF LEAGUE RULES AND REGULATIONS

The SSV Ladies 18-hole Golf League will meet every Tuesday and Thursday.

The sign-up sheet will be posted in the Pro Shop. Once the pairings are completed, you need to notify the Pro Shop to cancel. Deadline to sign up is 48 hours in advance.

USGA and local course Rules and Regulations will apply during league and tournament play with the following rule modifications in effect:

1. Only paid members of the SSV Ladies 18-Hole Golf League are eligible to compete for prizes or join the hole-in-one club.
2. No person may play as a guest more than two (2) times without applying for membership.
3. Maximum SSV course handicap is 36.
4. All new member applications must meet the following requirements:
 - A) Be a resident of SSV.
 - B) Have an approved handicap by: a) having established a handicap in the SSV Couples Club or b) playing three 18-hole rounds in the Ladies League.
5. All competitors in a Trophy Tournament must be a member for thirty (30) days and have played in five (5) regular league play days as a member.
6. Ties during Club Championship Tournament will be decided by hole by hole score on the scorecard to determine the winner, starting with lowest handicap hole moving forward.
7. Each player must use their own clubs during league and tournament games with maximum of fourteen (14) clubs in your bag.
8. No two-way clubs are allowed except for putters.
9. There must be a maximum of two (2) scorekeepers per group with player's names listed on both cards in the same sequence.
10. The first player ready on the tee box should hit once the fairway is clear – play ready golf.
11. For out-of-bounds or lost balls, USGA rules apply.
12. When a ball lands in the rough, play it where it lies.

The Executive Board will have the power to make recommendations for changes in the standard rules, as they deem necessary.

Fair play and golf etiquette is expected from each player during League and Tournament games. Any player not adhering to the rules and regulations during a game will be subject to disqualification.

ETIQUETTE AND READY GOLF GUIDE

January 22, 2018

GOLF ETIQUETTE

- Always play Ready Golf (see ready golf guidelines below).
- Identify your ball before teeing off – announce your balls brand, number and color.
- Don't stand in peripheral vision or directly behind (near backswing area) of another player.
- When player addresses ball on tee or fairway, keep still and watch where ball goes.
- Yell "FORE" if you hit a ball towards another golfer.
- Don't drive your cart or walk ahead of other players before they hit.
- Limit search for lost balls to 5 minutes.
- Replace all DIVOTS.
- Never ground your club in a hazard (ie: bunker).
- Always rake bunker after hitting.
- Repair ball marks on green.
- On the green, always mark ball directly behind your ball and replace ball exactly as you marked it.

READY GOLF GUIDE

The purpose of Ready Golf is to keep up with the group in front of you and keep play moving. It means always BEING READY to play, not playing when you are ready. Here are some simple guidelines our league would like to follow:

1. On the tee, any player who is ready should hit. Tee off as soon as group ahead is clear.
2. All players should go to their own balls as soon as possible and get ready to hit. While waiting choose your club, think about the shot, stand at your ball ready to step up and hit as soon as it is your turn.
3. If in a golf cart with a partner, drop partner first, then drive to your own ball. Drivers should not wait for their partner to hit and then drive to their own ball. (unless you would be in their line of flight).
4. Don't wait on another player if you can safely hit your ball. ex: (they are looking for their ball, they hit out of bunker and are raking, or fetching ball from gravel).
5. When a ball is lost hit your shot FIRST and then look for the lost ball.
6. ALWAYS leave your golf carts and clubs at the back side of the green or side closest to the next tee, pin high or beyond.
7. Mark your ball immediately once you are on the green. If you are in front of the green and chip/pitch on, mark your ball first then move your golf cart and clubs to the back or side of the green before playing your next shot.
8. Once your group is on the green, person closest to pin should be responsible for tending or removing the flag. Be sure flagstick is out of everyone's way.
9. While waiting survey your putt and be ready when it is your turn. If possible rid your line of loose debris and line up your putt while waiting for others.
10. Please don't stay after you've finished the hole to write down the scores, do that at the next tee .

Re: Rules of Play and Golf Privilege Suspensions

Rules of Play:

SSGC implemented the "Rules of Play" for all golfers to help insure that all golfers would be able to continue to enjoy playing golf at SSGC. The 7 simple "Rules of Play" are posted in the Pro Shop and on the rental golf carts for your review. The rules are designed to make sure the golf course does not sustain damage from continued play and golf cart misuse on the golf course. The "Rules of Play" are as follows:

1. Observe 90 degree rule unless noted.
2. Please keep the carts on the cart path around the tees and around the greens.
3. Please fix your ball marks and replace your divots.
4. Please keep your carts out of the granite areas.
5. Granite areas are considered non playable areas and free relief is recommended.
6. Play ready golf.
7. Have fun.

Chronic "Rules of Play" Violators:

If a Member, Resident or Public Golfer is continuously disregarding the "Rules of Play" and is warned about those violations by the SSGC staff, all golf privileges will be suspended after two warnings of those violations. The suspension will depend on the nature of the violation(s) and will be at the sole discretion of the SSGC General Manager.

Immediate Suspension of Golfing Privileges:

An immediate suspension of all golfing privileges for Members, Residents or Public golfers will be implemented with the following violations:

- i) Start playing golf without prior check in with the Pro Shop;
- ii) Use practice balls on the practice range that are not dispensed at SSGC;
- iii) Picks up practice balls off the practice range and
- iv) Any other major violation(s) in the sole discretion of the SSGC General Manager.

An immediate suspension of golfing privileges will require the approval of the Board of Directors before the immediate suspension can be lifted.
